

#### From the Management Office...

#### **2013 CRANE LAKES RESIDENTS STICKERS**

The blue and white 2013 stickers that have been given to residents to use on the gate guard side will become obsolete January 1, 2014 and no more will be issued. Residents have been given out these stickers to non-resident family members and friends. Everyone that is not a resident and have not been issued a resident sticker will have to stop at the gatehouse before entering. We are sorry for the inconvenience, but we want to make sure Crane Lakes is a safe place for everyone to live and feel safe.



#### **NEW GATE SYSTEM**

With the new stickers, please make sure when you drive through the gate, you go slow as it does not pick up the sticker at a fast speed and make sure to stay on the right side of the line. Please be sure to get your new sticker if you have not gotten it yet. The clickers will be turned off on January 31<sup>st</sup>. February 1<sup>st</sup>, if you do not have a sticker on your vehicle you will need to come in on the gatehouse side. Remember, they will be available to residents ONLY. You will need to bring your registration to your vehicles to receive a sticker or stickers. You will also need to bring in your clickers to trade them in. Each home will receive two (2) at no charge and if more is needed it will cost \$20.00 for each additional sticker including if your home is rented or sold. Renters will need to be registered with us and they will also need to bring in their registration to their vehicles. These stickers are for registered residents only not family members or friends no matter how frequent they come to see you. Management will have the option to turn the stickers off if the renter or homeowner moves out. If you have any question, please call the office.

#### **GOVERNMENT & UTILITY CHARGES/CABLE FEE INCREASE/RENT INREASE**

Crane Lakes Management would like to say "Thank You" to so many of our residents for the timely payment of the Government and Utility charges. Please be advised that anyone who has not paid the charges in January will receive a "Payment Demand" notice. Payments made will go to any outstanding charges first. The Government and Utility Charges were due January 1, 2014 in the amount of \$399.67. Please remember that cable is now \$42.50 and your rent increase takes effect this month.

#### **CRANE FEEDING**

Management has received complaints about residents feeding Crane's in the community which is prohibited. See inside this month courier for information on the danger.

#### **GATEHOUSE POLICIES**

There have been many questions on what the policy is for vendors and guests coming into the community. See below the policies that management would like followed:

- 1. Call the gatehouse to let them know you are expecting a vendor or sale people coming to your residence. Please be sure they are licensed and insured for your own protection.
- Call the gatehouse for all family and friends that come after 9 pm or you will be called no matter what time it is. If there is no answer, they will be turned away and not allowed to come into the community.
- If you notice anything suspicious (people/vehicles/activity) call the Port Orange Police Department at 911
  or 386-756-7400-non-emergency number. Our gate employees are not security guards and are only
  considered gate attendants.

As our night patrol check the community, they have noticed garage doors left open at night. Please be sure to check and make sure your garage doors are closed and your cars are locked before retiring. Make sure you follow the rules and do not park on the street overnight. While walking at night or early morning, please be sure to have a reflective device or clothing so you will be spotted. It is hard to see people at night and there are some dark spots. THE SPEED LIMIT IS 20 MPH IN THE ENTIRE COMMUNITY. PLEASE BE SURE NOT TO EXCEED THE SPEED LIMIT FOR THE SAFTEY OF ALL RESIDENTS AND GUESTS.

#### Why is feeding cranes prohibited?

Cranes fed by humans can become aggressive toward people. In several instances, children have been attacked by cranes. Cranes fed by humans also have been known to damage window screens and do other property damage. This behavior is probably a response of the birds to seeing their reflection, bringing out a territorial defense behavior (scratching at windows or shiny automobiles). Cranes also are more likely to tangle in human garbage in areas populated by people. Cranes are more likely to crash into power lines in urban areas where such aerial hazards are concentrated. Cranes attracted to people's yards for feed are put at risk as they walk across roads. Many sandhill cranes are killed each year on Florida roads (see photo). Attracting cranes to urban areas increases the threat of predation (especially to young cranes) by dogs or cats. Further, the cranes' diets, which normally are quite diverse, are disrupted when they eat one food item (such as corn), consistently. Heavy pesticide use in urban lawns also is of concern. Young sandhill cranes have died from pesticide poisoning.

#### Conclusion

It's never a good idea to feed wildlife. People inadvertently put cranes in harms way when they attract these birds to their yards with feed. Florida sandhill cranes have an abundance of natural foods (insects and small animals) and they do not need handouts from humans. There are many reasons why cranes should not be intentionally fed by humans. For the good of the cranes, please do not feed them.

Four things you can do to better coexist in "Crane Country"

Never feed cranes and encourage your neighbors not to feed cranes. Cranes are less likely to inhabit urban areas if easy meals are not provided.

 Cover or move automobiles so that cranes cannot see their reflections in the shiny surfaces. Windows or glass doors that the cranes attack can be temporarily covered with material so that the birds do not see their reflections.

Temporarily cover windows or screens. A string mounted on stakes about 2.5 feet off the ground will provide an exclusion "fence" around the parts of homes (window or pool screens) that are being damaged by cranes.

 Accept some digging for food. Cranes sometimes damage lawns and gardens as they dig for food such as mole crickets and beetle grubs. The birds, in this case, provide natural "biological control" of these common pests of turf.
