#### **RENT INCREASES.CABLE AND GOVERNMENT & UTILITY CHARGES**

By this time you should have received your rent increase notice. Please remember the new amount takes effect **January 1.2019**. The government and utility charges are due at that time as well. You may begin paying the government and utility charges before that date, **but it must be paid in full by the 1**st **of January 2019 to Crane Lakes**. Please indicate what you are paying for on your check. **The total amount for the government and utility charge is \$493.52**. Residents who have signed the form in the past few years for their taxes to be automatically deducted from their checking/savings account will be taken out again this year in the month of January 2019. If you are <u>not</u> sure if you did, please call the office. Please note the cable fee will increase January 1, 2018 to \$55.00.

#### **News from the Golf Course**

#### **Tips from the Tee:** Rule 26: Water Hazards

Perhaps the most important rule to know especially around these parts is Rule 26. I have had the good fortune to have played golf in a lot of places and never have I played a golf course with as much water as we have here at Crane Lakes. Literally there is water in play on every single hole. With that in mind let's review Rule 26.

There are **5 options (6 if a Drop Zone is available)** all with a penalty of **1 stroke** a player may choose from when it is known or virtually certain that the ball is lost in a water hazard.

- 1. Replay the shot
- 2. Drop a Ball within 2 club-lengths of the spot the ball last crossed the margin of the hazard no closer to the hole.
- 3. Drop a ball with within 2 club-lengths of the margin of the hazard on the opposite side of the hazard where the ball last crossed the hazard. This is a confusing one but think of it as dropping a ball on the equal and opposite side of the hazard.
  - 4. Get in the hazard and hit it
- 5. Keep the point the ball last crossed the margin of the hazard and the flagstick in line and go back as far as you would like and drop a ball. This one gets misunderstood because it its <a href="MOT">MOT</a> the line the ball entered the hazard that's important. It's where the ball last crossed the margin of the hazard and the hole itself that matters.
  - 6. Drop a ball within the Drop Zone if one is available. Drop Zones are usually permitted on holes 2,4,9,13,14

#### F.M.O. NEWS...

"Avoid a painful increase in the assessment on your leased lot"

#### **VOTE YES on Amendment # 2 on your ballot in November**

Your lot is assessed and taxed as commercial property. The assessments on commercial property have been restricted to 10% annually. Amendment # 2 MUST PASS by 60% in November or the restriction ENDS!

#### **Constitutional Amendment**

**Article XII, Section 27** 

"LIMITATIONS ON PROPERTY TAX ASSESSMENTS ---Proposing an amendment to the State Constitution to permanently retain provisions currently in effect, which will limit property tax assessment increases on specified non-homestead real property, except for school district taxes, to 10% each year. If approved, the amendment removes the scheduled repeal of such provisions in 2019 and shall take effect January 1, 2019."
