#### RENT IS DUE ON THE 1st of EACH MONTH

Remember, your rent is due on the  $1^{st}$  of each month. Late fees begin on the  $7^{th}$  day of the month. To avoid late fees, please have your rent in the office by the  $1^{st}$ . Late fees <u>WILL BE CHARGED</u> on the  $8^{th}$  day, no exceptions.

#### **GOVERNMENT & UTILITY CHARGES/CABLE FEE INCREASE/RENT INCREASE**

Crane Lakes Management would like to say "Thank You" to so many of our residents for the timely payment of the Government and Utility charges. Please be advised that anyone who has not paid the charges in January will receive a "Payment Demand" notice. Payments made will go to any outstanding charges first. The Government and Utility Charges are due January 1, 2025 in the amount of \$886.38. Please remember that cable is now \$67.00 and your rent increase takes effect this month. Please note: There are 2 flyers in the courier that Spectrum will be sending out these to every resident. You do not need to do anything if you want to continue with the service you have. If you would like to upgrade their service, they will need to have someone come replace their equipment. Please read the flyers.

#### **Reminder: GATEHOUSE POLICIES**

There have been many questions on what the policy is for vendors and guests coming into the community. See below the policies that management would like followed:

- 1. Call the gatehouse to let them know you are expecting a vendor or sale people coming to your residence. Please be sure they are licensed and insured for your own protection.
- 2. Call the gatehouse for all family and friends that come after 9 pm or you will be called no matter what time it is. If there is no answer, they will be turned away and not allowed to come into the community.
- 3. If you notice anything suspicious (people/vehicles/activity) call the Port Orange Police Department at 911 or 386-756-7400-non-emergency number. Our gate employees are not security guards and are only considered gate attendants.

Please be sure to check and make sure your garage doors are closed and your cars are locked before retiring. Make sure you follow the rules and do not park on the street overnight. While walking at night or early morning, please be sure to have a reflective device or clothing so you will be spotted. It is hard to see people at night and there are some dark spots. THE SPEED LIMIT IS 20 MPH IN THE ENTIRE COMMUNITY. PLEASE BE SURE NOT TO EXCEED THE SPEED LIMIT FOR THE SAFTEY OF ALL RESIDENTS AND GUESTS.

## Tips from the Tee: Get your eyes over the ball when putting

Check your eye position relative to the ball when your putting. It should be directly under your front eye or slightly and I mean slightly outside your eyes. The more your eyes get inside the target line the more arc your stroke will have. The more arc the more face rotation and that's not

a good thing when putting. Eyeline golf makes an inexpensive mirror that you can keep in your bag or cart to check this position regularly. It is the #1 training aid on all professional tours.

# F.M.ONEWS

For new residents who may not be aware of Florida Statute 222.17, it states that a person can show intent to maintain a Florida residence as a permanent home by filing a sworn Declaration of Domicile with the Clerk of the Court.

It is strongly recommended that individuals with one or more homes, that wish to claim Florida as their residence, declare Florida their Domicile.

If you are ever in need of any financial assistance such as Medicaid, before you receive this aid, you will be forced to spend down your assets to one home, one vehicle and a certain amount of monetary assets. Without this form, a doublewide home is considered two vehicles and if you own a car, you would be forced to sell two of the three vehicles in order to receive government aid.

You can go to the County Clerk's office on Orange Avenue in Port Orange to file the Declaration. It is less than \$20 and you only need to file this once unless you move in Florida. The Declaration of Domicile is on our website. Call 386-736-5915 to get to the Recording Office.

The F.M.O. needs all members to renew their memberships and talk to their friends and neighbors about the importance of joining the F.M.O. Membership dues are the only source of income to pay our lobbyist in Tallahassee. The F.M.O. is comprised of volunteers that are dedicated to preserving our way of life.

Applications to join the F.M.O. are in the hallway across from the gym and on our website. Just fill out and mail or drop in my mailbox at 2228 Crane Lakes Blvd. and I will mail it to the F.M.O. office for you. It is only \$30.00 for 1 year and \$75.00 for 3 years. 




