

FERAL CATS, FLORIDA SANDHILL CRANES AND OTHER WILD ANIMALS

Please do not feed feral cats, Florida Sandhill cranes or other wildlife in the community. They become a nuisance to your neighbors when they see you as their food source. It also can attract other animals to the area or create animals digging under your home or creating other damage to your home or your neighbor's home. It is your responsibility to hire a licensed and insured trapper when wild animals become a problem for you and your home. Please consider everyone in the community before feeding any wildlife. *Thank you*.

Tips from the Tee: Get your arm swing connected to your body rotation

The number one thing players ask for in lessons is to be more consistent. Next to having a fundamentally sound grip, getting your arm swing and your body rotation to work in harmony is the next most important thing. If the body rotation is faster than the arm swing then pushes and slices occur. If the body rotation is slower than the arm swing here comes the hooks. Try putting a small towel under your arm pits and across your chest and hitting balls. This keeps the two parts of the golf swing working in harmony.






