

From the Management Office ...

ATTENTION RESIDENTS

To protect yourselves, please use licensed and insured contractors per the prospectus. It might be a good idea for you to know the background of anyone you invite onto your home site for any reason. You are responsible for the conduct of persons you invite into the community.

RENT IS DUE ON THE 1st of EACH MONTH

Remember, your rent is due on the 1st of each month. Late fees begin accruing after the 7th day of the month. To avoid late fees, please have your rent in the office by the 1st. If you have any questions, please refer to your prospectus. Automatic debit from your checking account is available, just call our office.

APPLICATION FOR RESIDENCY, OCCUPANY OF HOMES, AND RENTERS

Some residents have allowed friends and family to live in their home without proper authorization. All potential residents must fill out our application for residency, have orientation with our office, pass a background check and be in good standing with our rules and regulations. **One person in the home must be age 55 or over with other occupants being a minimum age of 40.** There are some exceptions to this rule with management approval. This rule includes residents who rent their homes and the persons renting them. Anyone who will be renting your home may do so for a <u>minimum of six (6) months and must comply</u> <u>with the above</u>. Please do not jeopardize the tenancy of yourself and your home by not complying. We do keep an up-to-date HUD census in our office with copies of identification as residents move in and out of our community. <u>REMEMBER, NO ONE UNDER THE AGE OF "40" IS ALLOWED TO LIVE IN CRANE LAKES.</u>

GATEHOUSE ATTENDANTS

Please remember that our gate employees are not security guards and are only considered gate attendants. If you notice anything suspicious (people/vehicles/activity) call the Port Orange Police Department at 911 or 386-756-7400 (non-emergency number). They **are not** trained for dangerous encounters and should not be put in any dangerous situations.

GARBAGE, RECYCLE AND YARD WASTE

Please remember that Garbage, Recycle, and Yard Waste may be placed at the side of your driveway no earlier than the night before pickup. If you have contracted someone to trim and weed your lot, please make them aware of our rules and regulations. **Please do not put any debris on the grass.**

OVERNIGHT STREET PARKING

Please remember street parking is allowed for no longer than 3 consecutive hours during daylight hours. Residents and their guests must park in the driveway or in specially designated areas around the Community. There is no overnight parking allowed on the streets for any reasons. If an emergency vehicle comes in the community, they need to be able to go down all streets. This is a very important rule and someone's life may depend on it.

Tips from the Tee: Putting Made simple

Limit the amount your putter face rotates during your stroke and limit the amount of arc in your stroke. Although its impossible for the putter to do so, we want the stroke to be relatively straight back and straight though the ball. We also want the putter so stay square to the ball as much as possible. If you can do those two things then your putting will be much more consistent. To practice this lay two clubs down parallel to your target line about five feet from the hole. They should be just wider than your putter. Make some putts in between the clubs thinking straight back-straight through.




