### Tips from the Tee: The same swing doesn't work for every club


Golf is hard. There is no way around it. Its one of the few sports I know if that requires us to learn how to use 14 different clubs. Each of these clubs gets used a little different. For simplicity let's think of all the clubs, with the exception of the putter, in three groups. The groups are irons, fairway woods, and Driver. It is essential that you understand how each of these groups of clubs work differently. First irons are basically played in the middle of the stance and you must strike the ball with a descending angle of attack. Meaning we need to hit down through the ball. If you try to lift the ball or hit up on it you're going to fail. The fairway woods get played slightly ahead of the center of the stance but still require a slightly descending angle of attack. Yes, hit down on your fairway woods. Even taking a little divot on the other side of the ball is okay. Finally, the Driver gets played in the front of the stance. You must hit up on the ball with Driver. This is the only club in the bag that we hit up on other than putter. More on the putter at a later time. Understanding how each club works is like understanding the difference between a fork, a knife, and a spoon. Sure, they are all utensils but we use them much different.




