RENT INCREASES.CABLE AND GOVERNMENT & UTILITY CHARGES

By this time, you should have received your rent increase notice. Please remember the new amount takes effect January 1, 2025. The government and utility charges are due at that time as well. You may begin paying the government and utility charges before that date, but it must be paid in full by the 1st of January 2025 to Crane Lakes. Make sure all checks are payable to Crane Lakes, and please indicate what you are paying for on your check. The total amount for the government and utility charge is \$886.38. Residents who have signed the form in the past few years for their taxes to be automatically deducted from their checking/savings account will be taken out again this year in the month of January 2025. If you are not sure if you did, please call the office. Please note: Cable Fee will increase January 1, 2025 to \$67.00.

WATER UNDER YOUR HOME?

Occasionally management receives complaints that some residents have water under their home. Crane Lakes is not responsible for water going underneath your home unless it is a sprinkler issue. If you believe a sprinkler is the problem, we can gladly assist you in that regard; otherwise, water issues under the home are the residents' responsibility. It may be your downspouts, curbing, heavy rains or other issues causing the problem. Many residents have installed drains under their home at their own expense.




